
Assembly

1. INSTALLING THE STANDS

Using a **Phillips screwdriver**

Do not install the stands if you want to wall mount your TV. See your wall mount instructions for mount installation details.

- Place the TV screen-down on a clean, flat, soft surface (e.g.: blanket) to prevent scratches or damage to the screen.
- Use a Phillips screwdriver to attach each stand with the provided screws. Make sure the stand screws are fully tightened and the stands do not shift or move.
- 3. Place the TV upright on a stable, level surface.







CONNECTING TO POWER

After connecting all your devices, connect the power cord to a power outlet. The TV enters standby mode and its indicator light turns red.

Setup

ACTIVATION:

Have your mobile device ready for the VIZIO app download.

If you have a wireless network, have the network password ready.

The first time you turn on the TV, the on-screen instructions will guide you through each of the steps necessary to get your TV ready to watch.
